Productivity While Working from Home During COVID-19 Pandemic is Unchanged or Increased for a Majority of Organizations in Northwest Arkansas



During the period of October 8 – November 8, 2020, NOARK - The Northwest Arkansas Human Resources Association conducted a survey of its members and affiliates in northwest Arkansas to determine workplace trends during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Key findings from the northwest Arkansas chapter of the Society for Human Resource Management report, The Impact of the COVID-19 Pandemic on the Northwest Arkansas Workforce as Reported by HR Professionals and Business Leaders include:

Productivity While Working from Home is Unchanged or Increased for a Majority of Organizations Represented by Survey Respondents. Forty percent of respondents report no significant change in productivity, while 21% of respondents report productivity increased and remained at that level. Six percent of survey respondents indicate a decrease in productivity and another 6% report productivity increased initially and then dropped.



Nearly 60% of Survey Respondents Foresee a Continuation of Work-from-Home in Some Form in Northwest Arkansas. Of the nearly 60% predicting some continuation of work-from-

home, 21% predict an indefinite continuation of work-from-home and 14% expect work-from-home to last through the first quarter of 2021. For 37% of respondents, the issue of work-from-home is not applicable.
